discriminate: to treat someone differently and/or unfairly

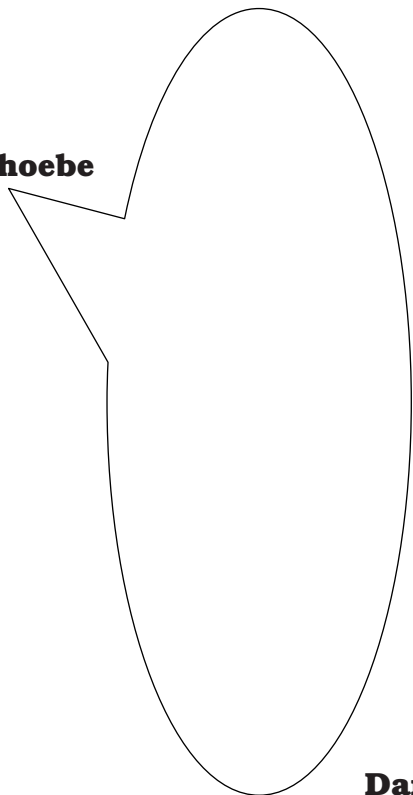
understanding: knowledge that is based on understanding or experience

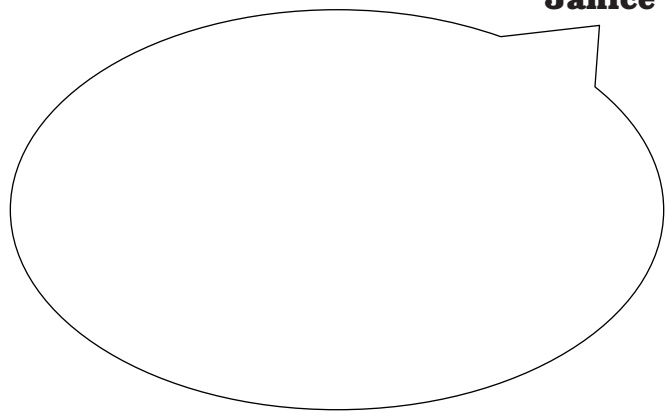
